### **Objectives:**

- Support primary care clinic efforts manage and treat their patients with HCV and HBC onsite, rather than routinely refer patients to specialty clinics.
- Use tele-education and case-based learning to mentor and guide primary care providers so that they develop sufficient knowledge to manage their patients with HCV or HBV, increasing the capacity to treat patients otherwise difficult to reach.
- Support micro-elimination of HCV by eliminating this infection in high prevalence populations as a strategy to incrementally achieve national elimination and improve the health of our communities.
