

Emergency Department (ED) (24/7)

No visitors, except:

ED Pediatric Patients	1 parent/guardian
ED Vulnerable/Incapacitated	1 adult
ED Imminent End of Life Patients	2 adults
ED Patients with Disabilities	1 support person

Hospital inpatient patients

No visitors, except compassionate care*

Inpatients identified as vulnerable (24/7)

1 support person

Inpatient pediatric patients (24/7)

1 parent/guardian allowed per 24 hours, including overnight, except compassionate care*

Newborns/NICU (24/7)

1 parent/guardian (Mother and 1 other identified visitor per stay)

Labor & Delivery patients (24/7)

1 adult visitor per stay, allowed per 24 hours, including overnight
1 Hennepin Healthcare doula or other professional doula

Outpatient surgical service and procedural areas

1 support person for each patient
1 parent/guardian for pediatric patient

Outpatient clinic adult patients needing assistance (during clinic hours)

1 support person

Outpatient clinic pediatric patients (during clinic hours)

1 parent or guardian

Compassionate care patients (24/7)*Rotations encouraged between 10am and 8pm**

2 visitors at a time (additional rotation allowed up to six). Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times and wear a mask for the duration of their visit. **Visitors are required to check in and out at the Welcome Desks or your family will not be able to rotate visitors.**

ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES:

- Only healthy visitors allowed. Visitor health screening includes a symptom/exposure review.
- Visitors must wear an EZ Pass badge when provided at all times and will be required to stay in the patient room, including Peds and NICU parents/grandparents with wristbands.
- Visitors will be required to wear a mask at all times, and additional Personal Protective Equipment as requested.
- All visitors for hospitalized patients must enter through 730 S. 8th Street (Red 1 Entrance). Visitor processing is taking place at Purple 2 Skyway, Red 1 and Blue 1 (900 S. 8th Street) Information Desks.
- Clergy members and legal counsel are not counted as visitors.
