Who are we?

We are a team of caring doctors, nurses, psychologists, social workers and support staff. Our mission is to care for children, adolescents and young adults who identify as gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, queer, gender-questioning or gender-nonconforming.

What services do we provide?

We provide full, gender-affirming care including:

- Primary care (e.g. checkups and vaccines)
- Mental health care (individual & family therapy, psychological evaluation and treatment with medicine)
- Puberty suppression
- Gender-affirming hormone therapy
- Referral to surgeons or specialists
- Referral to community help

What happens at the first visit?

You will meet with a doctor, a psychologist, and a social worker. The visit will last about 2-3 hours. We do not have to do a body exam or blood draw at your first visit if that worries you. We just want to get to know you and your family. We want to learn how we can best support you on your journey.

We ask that parents fill out the following forms before the first visit:

- Childhood Gender Identity and Experience – Gender Spectrum
- AQ-10
- Child and Family Information Form

We collect the forms to make your first visit easier. Please answer the questions to the amount that you feel comfortable.
