492	APP Leadership Program Fund	Support program for Advanced Practice Providers in leadership positions.
119	Aqui Para Ti – APT	Funds used for the Aqui Para Ti (Here for You) program which supports Hispanic youth from 12- 20 years old with issues such as health, teen pregnancy and sexual matters.
657	Artist in Residence Fund	Artist in Residence for Pediatric and Cancer Center.
356	Belzer Family Provider Wellness & Education Fund	Fosters a culture of wellness among the clinical faculty through educational initiatives.
148	Between Us Program Fund	Supports parents raising teens with workshops and trainings. Support teens with sexual health education and confidential services. The program promotes and advocates for teens receiving care through HHS.
614	Brooklyn Park Clinic Fund	Supports the health and wellness of patients at the Brooklyn Park Clinic.

192	Cardiac Rehab Resource Fund	Funds will be used to 1) support the patient experience in graduating their phase 2 cardiac rehab program 2) provide resources to graduating patients for physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual well-being sustainment after completion of the phase 2 program and 3) subsidize continued education opportunities for cardiac rehab personnel.
600	Cardiac Rehab Scholarship Fund	Helps patients pay for therapy sessions in the cardiac rehab unit.
427	Cardiology Education Fund (pending)	Purchase of teaching materials and supplies (text books, papers, publications, etc), attendance at cardiology related conferences, cardiology focused CME/training expenses (registration, travel, lodging). Funds can be used for expenses related to HHS System Physicians, residents and students training at HCMC, and HCMC advanced practice providers.
435	Cardiology/CARE Fund	Supports the Cardiology department and CARE program by enhancing both the patient, staff and provider experience.
602	Child Mental Health Fund	Provides toys and play equipment for child psych.
300	Children's Literacy Fund	Promotes literacy and interest in books by young patients, visitors and their families. Programs include Holiday Book Buddy Program and Reach Out and Read.

510	Knapp Rehab Fund	Purchases patient or nursing equipment or supplies that facilitate patient or nursing education.

565	NICU AngelEye Service Fund	Funds AngelEye services at HHS. AngelEye video monitors connect parents to their infant and the care team with around the clock live-streaming video and real time updates with photos, texts, and recorded messages from the healthcare team.
126	NICU Urgent Needs Fund	Assists patients who have a child in the NICU for extended periods of time to remain at the child's side. Helps meet special needs of families and supports service improvements.
434	Nurse Midwife Fund	Provides program supplies and educational materials to improve the patient care experience and outcomes.
163	Nursing Assistance Fund	Provides a variety of support to HHS nursing staff.

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345	Nursing Education Fund	Provide funding for staff nurses and nurse leaders to attend conferences relevant to their development and advancement for nursing practice at Hennepin Healthcare.
