Visiting hours from 8am to 10pm

Emergency Department (ED) (24/7)

No visitors until patient is roomed, waiting room exceptions:

ED Pediatric Patients	2 parents/guardians
ED Vulnerable/Incapacitated	1 adult
ED Imminent End of Life Patients	2 adults
ED Patients with Disabilities	1 support person

Newborns/NICU (Non COVID)

Mother and 2 other identified badge holders may accompany

1 other visitor each

Max 2 at bedside

Newborns/NICU (COVID)

2 COVID-negative visitors per stay

Mother may visit when no longer infectious

OB/Labor and Delivery patients (Non COVID)

2 adult visitors at bedside

Doula is allowed to support labor

2 adult visitors are allowed overnight

OB/Labor and Delivery patients (COVID)

1 adult visitor per stay, including overnight

Outpatient surgical service and procedural areas (Non COVID)

1 visitor per patient in pre-op and PACU at a time

A second visitor may swap with the first visitor in PACU to allow

2 different visitors per patient

Outpatient clinic patients (during clinic hours)

Clinic & Specialty Center, Campus Clinics, Community Clinics

Maximum recommendations is 2 visitors in an exam room, not including the patient, subject to provider discretion

Inpatient Psychiatry patients

Visitors allowed, by appointment only

Inpatient adult patients (Non COVID)

2 visitors per day during designated visitor hours, except compassionate care*

1 overnight visitor per patient in private rooms

Visitor must arrive by 10pm

Inpatient adult patients (COVID)

No visitors, except compassionate care*

Inpatient pediatric patients (Non COVID)

2 visitors per day, including overnight, except compassionate care*

Inpatient pediatric patients (COVID)

2 visitors per stay, including overnight, except compassionate care*

*Compassionate care visitation for patients (24/7) Rotations encouraged between 8am and 10pm

2 visitors at a time. Multiple family allowed to rotate as agreed upon. Ideal limit six people total, with exceptions. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Mask required. Family groups allowed for care conferences off unit. Visitors are required to check in and out at the Welcome Desks or your family will not be able to rotate visitors. For inpatient adult COVID patients, visitor must stay in patient room, cannot go elsewhere in the hospital.

ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES:

- Visiting hours from 8am to 10pm
- Only healthy visitors allowed. Visitor health screening includes a symptom/exposure review.
- Visitors will be required to wear a mask at all times, and additional personal protective equipment as requested.
- Visitors for hospitalized patients enter through 730 S. 8th Street (Red 1 Entrance) 24/7.
- Visitor processing also taking place at Purple 2 skyway and Blue 1 (900 S. 8th Street) Information Desk during the day.
- Clergy, chaplain, spiritual leaders, legal counsel, qualified rehabilitation professionals, law enforcement, county agencies, mothers of newborn intensive care unit infants and employees are not included in the visitor count.
- Visitors must be 12 and older
 - Compassionate exceptions will be made at the unit level for younger visitors able to wear a mask for the entire visit.
 - Compassionate exceptions will be made for a twin of an NICU infant.
