Fund	Fund Name	Purpose
121	Extraordinary Kids Fund	Enhances the pediatric experience at HCMC. Purchase supplies and equipment that help distract, support, educate, and engage pediatric patients to minimize anxiety and increase positive coping during hospitalization.
129	Emergency Clothing Room	Purchases emergency clothing for patients.
150	Patient Experience Fund	To provide patient amenities and enhance the patient experience.
151	Family Lodging Assistance Fund	To support temporary lodging for families and any other expenses related to lodging, with patients in long-term care situations at the hospital or extended outpatient care.

657	<b>Artist in Residence Fund</b>	Artist in Residence for Pediatric and Cancer Center.
356	<b>Belzer Family Provider Wellness &amp; Education Fund</b>	Fosters a culture of wellness among the clinical faculty through educational initiatives.
148	<b>Between Us Program Fund</b>	Supports parents raising teens with workshops and training. Support teens with sexual health education and confidential services. The program promotes and advocates for teens receiving care through HHS.

126	<b>NICU Urgent Needs Fund</b>	Assists patients who have a child in the NICU for extended periods of time to remain at the child's side. Helps meet special needs of families and supports service improvements.
434	<b>Nurse Midwife Fund</b>	Provides program supplies and educational materials to improve the patient care experience and outcomes.
163	<b>Nursing Assistance Fund</b>	Provides a variety of support to HHS nursing staff.
607	<b>Oncology Dentistry Fund</b>	Provides assistance to oncology patients needing dentistry support.
350	<b>Organ, Tissue and Eye Donation Support Fund (was Wall of Heroes Fund)</b>	Maintains the Wall of Heroes installation that honors the memories of Organ/Tissue donors.

159	<b>Pediatric Vaccine Van Fund</b>	Serves children in the community during the pandemic with vaccinations.
545	<b>Pediatrics Fund</b>	Funds to be used for patients, staff and visitors of the Pediatric Area.
128	<b>PICU Urgent Need Fund</b>	Assists patients who have a child here for extended periods of time to remain at the child's bedside. Helps meet special needs of families and supports service improvements.
112	<b>Positive Care Urgent Needs Fund</b>	Assist with urgent needs of people living with HIV/AIDS, including medical costs, health insurance premiums and other basic needs not attainable through community resources.
